Learning Online Program Information

- Learning Online courses are *Asynchronous*. Students work individually through a course with the guidance of their Learning Online teacher. Students are not required to log into courses and participate during a set time.
- All course work is completed online, with the exception of the mathematics final, which is a paper and pencil exam.
- Students have 24 – 7 access to courses. The Learning Online site is mobile friendly, providing students the ability to work on a computer, tablet, or smart phone.
- Students should expect to spend approximately 5 hours a week working on their online class. A calendar of due dates is posted in each course to help guide students and keep them on pace.
- Learning Online teachers hold virtual office hours outside of the regular school day. This is an opportunity for students to connect with their instructors and receive additional help in a class.
- Learning Online has a variety of supports for online learners, including program orientations, access to a preparation course, and an online help desk.
- Learning Online sends out regular communications, including progress reports, attendance reminders, and grade reports.
