

How to Add a Quiz in Moodle

Step One: Turn on editing.

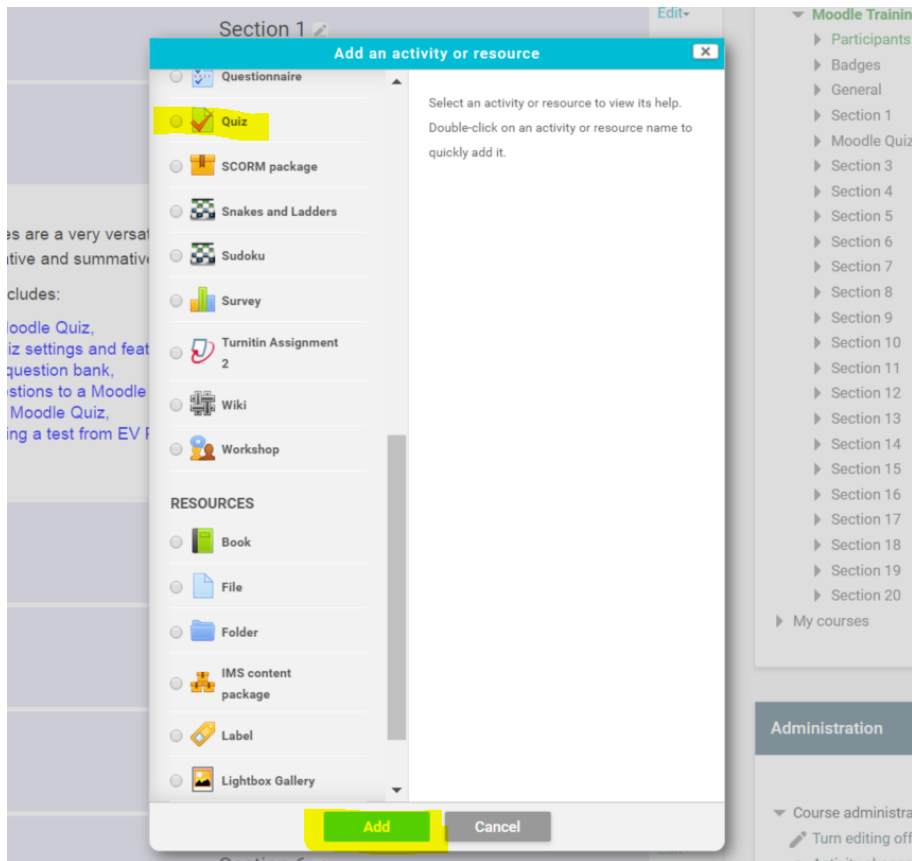
