

Setting Restrictions in Moodle

The restrict access feature allows teachers to set when an activities is available and to whom.

Step One: Under “Edit Settings” select Restrict Access and click on Add Restriction.

Step Two: Select the Restriction you would like to place on the activity.

Add restriction...	
Date	Prevent access until (or from) a specified date and time.
Grade	Require students to achieve a specified grade.
User profile	Control access based on fields within the student's profile.
Restriction set	Add a set of nested restrictions to apply complex logic.
Cancel	

Date – You can set an activity to appear or disappear on a certain date. This works as an automated hide/unhide feature.

Grade – You can set an activity to appear if a student achieves or does not achieve a certain mark on task. For example, if you have prerequisite check quiz at the beginning of the unit, extra practice questions could be set to appear for students who do not achieve a certain grade.

User Profile – You can set an activity to appear for students based on a variety of profile items including first and last name. If you had two exams on the same topic, certain students could be assigned to one and the rest to the other. This would also be helpful if you made an alternate exam for a student. Only that student would see the alternate.

Restriction Set – Allows you to set a restriction within a restriction.
